

Privacy and Cookies Policy

I. Personal data

1. Data Controller

PCC Intermodal S.A. with registered office in Gdynia, 81-061, ul. Hutnicza 16, entered into - the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register, kept by the District Court for Gdańsk-Północ in Gdańsk, the 8th Economic Department of the National Court Register under number KRS 0000297665, NIP (tax identification number): 749-196-84-81, REGON (Polish business registry number) is the Data Controller.

2. Processing of personal data

Through the Controller's websites(www.pccintermodal.pl, www.pcc-intermodal.pl), personal data are processed on the basis of the consent given by the User. During a visit to the website, information concerning the User's visit is collected automatically, e.g. IP address, domain name, browser type, operating system type, etc.

3. Protection of personal data

The Data Controller declares that

- a) it processes Personal Data lawfully, fairly, and in a transparent manner,
- b) it collects Personal Data for specific and legitimate purposes,
- c) it applies technical and organisational measures ensuring protection of personal data processing as appropriate to threats and category of data, and in particular it protects Users' personal data against loss, destruction, misuse, unlawful processing or modification,
- d) it stores Personal Data for no longer than it is necessary for the purposes for which it is processed,
- e) only persons authorized to process personal data and obliged to keep such data confidential have access to such data.

4. Rights of the data subjects

The Company shall ensure enforcement of rights under Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC ("GDPR"). In any case, the data subject has the right:

- a) to request access to the content of their data, including but not limited to obtaining information what Personal Data are processed,
- b) to request rectification, deletion or restriction of processing of Personal Data, if they are incorrect or have been processed unlawfully,
- c) to object to the processing,
- d) to transfer Personal Data,
- e) to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection,
- f) to withdraw consent for the processing of Personal Data at any time, provided that the withdrawal of consent shall not have retroactive effect, i.e. it does not affect the legality of the processing of Personal Data that the Company performed before the withdrawal of consent, and the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.

II. Purposes of Personal Data processing

1. Personal data may be processed by the Controller for, but not limited to the following purposes:
 - a) analytical and statistical - consisting of analyses of users' activities and their preferences in order to improve website functionality,
 - b) communication - responding to messages or feedback,

- c) direct marketing - consisting in sending commercial information by e-mail about products and services provided by the Administrator.
2. Personal data may be disclosed to third parties only within the limits of the law, for the purpose and to the extent necessary for the proper implementation and operation of the websites and in the legitimate interest of the Controller in accordance with national law or European Union law. The Controller may commission the processing of personal data, e.g. to entities supporting the Controller in the field of IT.
3. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the legitimate interest of the Controller (Article 6(1)(f) of GDPR). Providing personal data is voluntary, however, it may be necessary, e.g. in order to respond to an inquiry or for the purpose of correspondence.

III. Cookies

1. Cookies are IT data, in particular small text files saved and stored on devices used the User to access the Controller's website.
2. Cookies used by the Controller are safe for the User's Device. It is not possible for viruses or other unwanted or malicious software to enter the devices. These cookies are used for identification of the software used by the User and customization of the website for each User.
3. The Controller uses cookies for, among other purposes:
 - a) optimization of the use of the Controller's websites, that is recognition of the User's device and adjustment of the websites to his/her individual needs, saving the settings selected by the User and personalisation of the interface,
 - b) analysis and research - involving the creation of anonymous statistics to understand how and how often Users use the Company's websites, in order to improve their structure and content,
 - c) security - to protect against possible threats or problems with the services.
4. As part of the websites, the Controller uses two basic types of cookies, i.e. session and permanent cookies:
 - a) session cookies are temporary files that are stored on the User's device until it leaves the website or the Internet browser is switched off. The stored information is then permanently deleted from the Device memory,
 - b) persistent cookies are stored in the User's device for the time specified in the parameters of cookies or until they are deleted by the User. End of the browser session or switching off the device does not remove them from the User's device.
5. The information is not linked in any way to the User's personal information and is not used to determine its identity. The scope of information that is collected automatically depends on the individual settings of the User's web browser.
6. The User can independently and at any time change the settings for cookies specifying the conditions for their storage and access to the User Device by cookies. Settings may be changed by means of the web browser. Detailed information about the possibility and methods of cookies handling is available in the settings of web browsers.
7. The User may, at any time, delete the cookies stored on its terminal equipment or block their placement via the Internet browser it uses.
8. The Controller informs that limiting or disabling the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the Controller's website.

IV. Links to other pages

The Controller's websites may contain external links to other websites. When leaving the Controller's websites (e.g. by following a link to a website located in another domain), the User enters an area where this Privacy Policy does not apply. The Company is not responsible for the privacy policies in force on other websites. For security reasons, we recommend that, before using the resources offered by other websites or services, you read the privacy and cookie policy of the entity in question and, if they are not

available, you contact the Controller of a website or service in question to obtain information in this regard.
