Dear Partners,

current geopolitical and economic situation heavily affects global fuel markets and in consequence unseen dynamics of fuel prices increase in Poland.

To counter such dangerous dynamic of increased fuel costs, crucial element within every transport company, PCC Intermodal decided to implement, with immediate effect, starting 14.03.2022 **emergency fuel surcharge** (bunker adjustment factor - BAF).

BAF, expressed as an percentage, based on every Thursday publication of wholesale fuel price by PKN ORLEN (<https://a.orklen.pl/PL/DlaBiznesu/HurtoweCenyPaliw/Strony/archiwum-cen.aspx?Fuel=ONEkodiesel&Year=2022>), will be valid for whole consecutive week. BAF will be presented as separate position on the invoices.

Amount of BAF will be calculated for every container, based on **total rate for organization of the transport**, as per currently valid offer and fixed at the day of confirmation / booking acceptance by PCC Intermodal, as follows:

Diesel price below PLN 5 500	BAF = 0
Diesel price PLN 5 501 – 6 000	BAF = 1%
Diesel price PLN 6 001 – 6 500	BAF = 2%
Diesel price PLN 6 501 – 7 000	BAF = 3%
Diesel price PLN 7 001 – 7 500	BAF = 4%
Diesel price PLN 7 501 – 8 000	BAF = 5%
Diesel price PLN 8 001 – 8 500	BAF = 6%
Diesel price PLN 8 501 – 9 000	BAF = 7%
Diesel price PLN 9 001 – 9 500	BAF = 8%
Diesel price PLN 9 501 – 10 000	BAF = 9%
Etc.	

Example:

Diesel price announced on 10.03.2022, is at the level of PLN 7 348,-/m³.

That means, that BAF level valid for 14-20.03.2022 will be equal to 4%.

Meanwhile, we'd like to inform You that all our services are functional – except for suspended Brest service - not impaired by fuel shortage and that our implemented remedies are aiming at keeping our stable and regular intermodal services at Your disposal.
