Dear Partners,

In response to the expectation of our business partners, regarding simplification of current BAF procedures used by PCCI (announced in separate advisory on 10.03.2022), we decided to change calculation frequency and height of the BAF surcharge, beginning July.

Starting 01.07.2022, BAF will be expressed as a percentage, based on the wholesale diesel price ("ekodiesel") by PKN ORLEN (<https://www.orklen.pl/pl/dla-biznesu/hurtowe-ceny-paliw?Fuel=ONEkodiesel&Year=2022#paliwa-archive>), published on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of each month (if that day is weekend or holiday, then Friday before the weekend will be applied) and will be valid for whole **consecutive month**, without change.

Amount of BAF will be calculated for every container, based on **total rate for organization of the transport**, from the offer valid at the time of sending complete booking to PCC Intermodal, as follows:

Diesel price below PLN 5 500	BAF = 0
Diesel price PLN 5 501 – 6 000	BAF = 3%
Diesel price PLN 6 001 – 6 500	BAF = 4%
Diesel price PLN 6 501 – 7 000	BAF = 5%
Diesel price PLN 7 001 – 7 500	BAF = 6%
Diesel price PLN 7 501 – 8 000	BAF = 7%
Diesel price PLN 8 001 – 8 500	BAF = 8%
Diesel price PLN 8 501 – 9 000	BAF = 9%
Diesel price PLN 9 001 – 9 500	BAF = 10%
Diesel price PLN 9 501 – 10 000	BAF = 11%
etc.	

*Example:*

*Diesel price announced on 13.05.2022, is at the level of PLN 6 515,-/m<sup>3</sup>.*

*That means, that BAF level valid for June will be equal to 5%.*

*BAF level for July, will be calculated based on diesel price published on 15.06.2022.*

BAF will remain to be presented as separate position on the invoices.
