


Terminal PCC Intermodal Brzeg Dolny



RULES APPLICABLE TO DRIVERS

- 1. Speed Limit:
 - a) On the internal access road 30 km/h
 - b) In the terminal 30 km/h.
- 2. Obligation to Follow Horizontal and Vertical Signage as Well as Road Traffic Regulations.
- 3. Obligation to Exercise Particular Caution When Crossing Automatic Railway Gates.
- 4. Entry to the Terminal Allowed Only with Permission from a PCC Intermodal Employee or Authorized Security Personnel,
- 5. Loading Equipment (Reach Stackers and Cranes) and Other Vehicles with a Yellow Hook Have Absolute Priority. Attention! The operator of these devices has limited visibility! Exercise special caution when passing near them and establish visual contact.
- 6. Attention! Cranes are Operated Remotely! Exercise special caution in their working areas!
- 7. Drivers! If you see a crane with a loaded container crossing your path, stop and do not pass under the load!
- 8. Mandatory Use of Reflective Vests Across the Entire Terminal Premises and Helmets Within Crane Work Areas!
- 9. Total Smoking Ban for Tobacco Products and E-Cigarettes on Terminal Premises.
- 10. Driver Must Monitor Channel 16 of the CB Radio if Equipped.

- 11. Attention! No Exiting the Cabin in the Truck Lane or Within the Work Area of Loading Equipment. Exiting is only allowed with the operator's consent or in case of personal safety concerns. This rule does not apply to the PST areas.
- 12. Driver, if you decide to leave the cab wear a helmet and vest, position yourself at the cab and watch the unloading/loading of the container.
- 13. Absolute Prohibition of Reversing in the Truck Lane! The Terminal operates as a one-way roundabout. All trailer adjustments, fifth wheel settings, etc., must be done in designated PST (Preparation Semi-Trailers) areas.
- 14. If You Need to Realign for Container Handover or Pickup, You Must Circumnavigate the Storage Yard Again and Enter the Truck Lane.
- 15. Service Vehicles Must Have Hazard Lights and Yellow Flashing Warning Lights Turned On.
- 16. Prohibition of Driving Too Close to Containers, Buildings, Tracks, and Containers Elevated on Stacks.
- 17. Prohibition of Using Mobile Phones While Driving Without a Hands-Free Kit.
- 18. Drivers Are Responsible for Pollution and Damage Caused During Transport and by Their Vehicles.
- 19. No Parking of Any Vehicles Is Allowed on the Terminal Premises. In special cases, the Shift Manager may temporarily designate safe parking areas.
- 20. Driver's Duties at the Gate Include: a) If the container is empty opening the doors and closing them after the container's condition has been verified by the gate employee.
 - b) If the container is full handing over documents to the gate employee.
 - c) Each time before entering the yard, unlocking the container, deploying the trailer legs, and preparing the fifth wheel.
 - d) Approaching the gate window to sign and collect documents for container handover or pickup.
- 21. Maximum of 4 Drivers Allowed in the Lounge. The lounge is monitored for property protection and safety within the Terminal.
- 22. For Stops Longer Than 5 Minutes, the Truck Engine Must Be Turned Off.
- 23. Traffic Rules at the Gates (gates numbered from the office building):
 - Entry: Gate 4 External Transport (all vehicles);
 - Gate 3 Internal Transport Only (PCCI vehicles and PCCR Group personnel).
 - Exit: Gate 2 Internal Transport Only (PCCI vehicles and PCCR Group personnel);
 - Gate 1 External Transport (all vehicles);
- 24. Gate Personnel Determine Possible Traffic Organization Changes. It is FORBIDDEN to drive against the flow of traffic! In exceptional situations, driving against the flow of traffic may be allowed, but only with prior consent from the gate employee (the decision to proceed must be adequately justified).
- 25. Transporting Persons Is Prohibited Without Prior Notification and Consent from the Shift Manager.
- 26. Taking Photos or Making Videos Using Cameras or Mobile Phones Is Prohibited on Terminal Premises.

GROSS NEGLIGENCE OF THE ABOVE RULES WILL RESULT IN SYSTEMATIC BLOCKING OF ACCESS TO PCC INTERMODAL TERMINALS!
